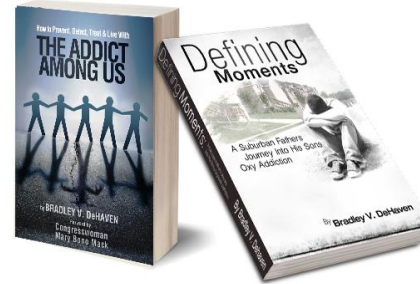

Brad is a financial planner, husband, and father of two sons, one of whom is a recovering prescription drug addict. In 2008, in an attempt to get his son into rehab rather than prison, he went undercover with a suburban police force to bust a drug dealer. While it appeared to be successful, the deal enabled disastrous immediate consequences. Ultimately, however, it led to the healing of an entire family.

Brad's life experiences became the subject of a memoir released in January 2011.

The story has drama and action, but it also has real education: Addiction to powerful "legal" drugs can lead even the most aware suburban families down a path they never saw coming—towards theft, prostitution, heroin, prison, and, too often, death.

Since then, he has written a second book, become a speaker and activist on the subject, hosts a radio show, and has interviewed hundreds of experts and others who are afflicted by addiction.
